# Regulation of the GP Bob Jungels

## **Article 1: Organization**

The GP Bob Jungels is organized by UC Dippach (c/o Serge Haag, 34, rue du Traité de Londres L-4989 SANEM) and takes place on the 12<sup>th</sup> September 2021. The 1.1 Junior Men Event runs under the FSCL and UCI regulations.

## **Article 2: Type of the Event**

The event, which is listed in the UCI World Junior Calendar, is open to athletes of the Men Junior categories. It is registered as a class 1.1 event. The race consists of **11 laps of 11,9 km and of 130,9 km in total** around the village of Dippach.

## **Article 3: Participation**

According to article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to foreign and national clubs, regional and mixed teams. Only riders in teams are authorized to participate. According to article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, teams must be formed of **6** riders. The number of starting riders who are registered on the entry form must be equal to the number set by the organiser. Teams registered first have prevalence.

## **Article 4: Race Headquarters**

The race headquarters for the start is open at 7.30 am and is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor in the “Centre Culturel Dippach”, 64A, rte de Luxembourg. Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters participation and to collect their race number at the race headquarters between 9.30 am and 10.45 am.

The race headquarters for the arrival shall be open from 4 pm to 7 pm and is located at the same place as for the start.

The Team Managers Meeting organized according to article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations is scheduled for 11 am and will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the “Centre Culturel Dippach” in the presence of the members of the Commissioners Panel.

## **Article 5: Radio-Tour**

Informations about the race will be broadcasted on the following frequency: **157,610**. The teams have to use their own Radios. Radios are **not** supplied by the organisation.

In case teams use Radios (other than Radio Tour), please respect the following directive:

In accordance with the amended law of May 30, 2005 on the organization of radio wave management, no one may use a frequency or radio channel in the territory of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg without having been authorized to do so.

After evaluating the application, the Minister of Communications and Media issues a temporary license to the applicant. Since this is a temporary license, i.e. with a duration of less than 30 days per year, the frequencies are free.

## **Article 6: Neutral technical support:**

3 Vehicles of the organizer UC Dippach accomplish the service.

## **Article 7: Medical service**

Medical Service in the race will be provided by Dr. Pascal Stamet (LUX) mobile phone: 00 352 621 220 412. Two ambulances will complete this service.

## **Article 8: Finishing time limits**

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than **8%** will not be placed. In exceptional circumstances, the time limit may be increased by the Commissioners Panel in agreement with the organizer (Article 2.3.039 of the UCI rules).

Additional to the time limit please note that the police can guarantee the road closure till 15' after the first arrival.

## **Article 9: Classifications:**

The following classifications will be issued:

1<sup>st</sup> of the event in overall time.

1<sup>st</sup> of the event in the category 1<sup>st</sup> year Junior.

1<sup>st</sup> Luxembourgish rider.

First 3 of the sprints:

3, 2, 1 points will be distributed every (2) two laps on the finish line starting with the third (3rd) crossing and also at the last lap with doubled points (6, 4, 2) at the finish.

For riders with the same amount of points, the numbers of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places will be taken into account.

If there should still be a draw, the final classification of the race will decide.

The team classification will be settled by the addition of the 3 best individual times of each team (Article 2.3.011 of the UCI).

## **Article 10: Prizes**

A total award of 1'215.- € will be distributed to the 20 first riders in the overall classification.

The following prizes are awarded:

50.- € for the best 1<sup>st</sup> year Junior.

A grand total of 1'615.- € will be awarded as prize money at the event.

All the prizes will be paid by bank transfer. Please communicate us your bank account number before the race via the enrolment form or via Email.

## **Article 11: Awards Ceremony**

In accordance with article 1.2.112 of the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

The first 3 riders of the race

The 1<sup>st</sup> of the Sprint Classification

The 1<sup>st</sup> of the Team Classification

The 1<sup>st</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Junior Classification

The 1<sup>st</sup> Luxembourgish rider

The riders will have to present themselves at the podium in a limit of maximum 20 minutes after crossing the finish line.

## **Article 12: Penalties**

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

### **Article 13: Anti-Doping**

The UCI anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable at this event. Moreover, in conformity with the law of Luxembourg, the Luxembourgish anti-doping legislation is applicable in addition to the UCI anti-doping regulations. Anti-doping tests will be made in the camper, placed approximately 200m after the finish line, under the supervision of the ALAD (Luxembourgish Anti-Doping Institution).

### **Article 14: Highway code**

All the drivers being part of the race have to respect the traffic regulations such as:

Speed limits (50 km/h inside the villages; 90 km/h outside the villages, ban of cell phones during driving (driver); attaching the seat belts, don't get up and don't lean out of the windows while the car is in motion, (article 143 of Road Traffic Rules of the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg).

The drivers have to follow the instructions given by the Police.

### **Article 15: Waste zone / Zone Natura 2000**

The organisation is trying hard to respect the nature, for this reason a waste zone, which is cleaned after the race, is set up. Please use at the most this zone to drop waste (gels, bottles...).

Between Km 7 and 9 is a "Zone Natura 2000". This is a special protected area in which it is **absolutely forbidden** to drop any waste or bottles.

Please respect our environment and nature.
